### ***Criminal record of MPs- High Level summary***

There are 153 newly elected MPs with criminal cases pending against them. Out of these, there are 73 MPs having serious charges against them. Here is the high level summary of the new Lok Sabha:

- Affidavits available for MPs - **535**
- MPs with criminal charges - **153 (28.60 %)**
- MPs with serious criminal charges - **74 (13.83 %)**
- Total criminal cases against MPs - **464**
- Total serious IPC sections against MPs - **268**
- Total crorepati MPs - **300**

As compared to 2004, the no of MPs with criminal records has gone up. There were 128 MPs with criminal cases in 2004 Lok Sabha out of which 55 had serious criminal records. There is an increase of about 19.5% in MPs with criminal records and 34.5% increase in the number of MPs with serious criminal records. There however is a decrease of 11.3% in the number of serious criminal charges on these MPs.

### ***Comparison of 10 MPs with most serious criminal records against them (in 2004 & 2009)***

Comparison of top 10 MPs with criminal records in 2004 and 2009 Lok Sabha Elections clearly indicates that number of candidates with very serious criminal backgrounds has declined. For the top 10 MPs with most serious criminal charges, the total number of cases decreased by 42%, count of serious IPC charges reduced by 32% with a 55% fall in murder charges.

## ***Red Alert constituency analysis***

There were a total of 192 red alert constituencies. As the following analysis shows, if voters have a choice, they prefer a clean and capable candidate. In the constituencies where there was only 1 candidate with criminal cases, voters chose 85% of the clean candidates and rejected most candidates with criminal background. In the constituencies where there were 2 candidates with criminal background, they chose clean candidates in 68% constituencies. The percentage of clean candidates however has gone down to around 40% in constituencies with 4 or 5 candidates. It went further down to 22% for candidates with 7 criminal backgrounds.
