

KARNATAKA Phase 2, Date of Election - **23 April 2009**

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE Date: Apr 14, 2009

National Election Watch¹ (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India. It has analyzed 1440 affidavits of candidates contesting in 11 states for the Phase 1 polls on April 16, 2009. This is the first press release for Phase 2 polls on April 23, 2009, and is for the State of Karnataka. In this phase, 17 out of 28 Lok Sabha constituencies in Karnataka are going to the polls.

National Election watch, Karnataka is a network of NGOs, civil society organizations, volunteers, and several eminent citizens.

Highlights

1. Total no. of Candidates in the April 23, 2009 Phase 2 elections in Karnataka elections with Criminal Records = 27 (i.e. 14.9% of 181 candidates), compared to 222 (i.e. 16% of 1425 candidates) at the All India level for Phase 1 polls on April 16, 2009.
2. Most of the major political parties in Karnataka have fielded candidates with criminal records, with top four being JD(S) 5 out of 11 (45.45%), BJP 6 out of 14 (42.9%), INC 4 out of 15 (26.7%) and BSP 3 out of 12 (25%).
3. Most states have candidates with criminal background contesting elections; Bihar is at the top with 51 candidates (or 26%) while Karnataka has 14.9%.
4. There are 15 charges of heinous nature on the candidates which includes, murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, extortion, etc. in Karnataka in the 17 constituencies compared to 306 charges in the 111 constituencies in Phase 1 at the All India level.
5. Karnataka has higher than the All India level of “Crorepatis” contesting. There are 45 or 24.9% compared to 93 “Crorepatis” (14%) at the All India level. Percentage of contesting crorepatis has increased from 9% in 2004 to 14% in 2009 at the All India level.
7. Among major parties, the average asset per candidate for JD(S) is Rs.19.1 crores, BJP Rs.7.27 crores, Congress is Rs.4.67 Crores, BSP Rs.0.98 crores
8. About 47% candidates have not furnished their PAN card details in Karnataka compared to 68% at the All India level.
9. Number of women candidates is just 11 out of 181 (6%) compared to 122 out of 1815 (7%) at the All India Phase 1 level.
10. About 56.5% of candidates are graduates, Post Graduates or Doctorates in Karnataka compared to 60% at the All India level.

Comparison with past elections

NEW was able to find 13 MLAs in 2008 who are re-contesting the elections in 2009 for the Lok Sabha. Within one year, their declared assets showed an increase of 39% from a total of Rs.69.4 crores to Rs.96.8 crores. Similarly, 7 MPs from the 14th Loksabha are re-contesting this time. Their assets went up in these five years from a total of Rs.7.63 crores to Rs.27.94 crores or 266%. Their increase in wealth is far more than inflation or the rate of growth of the GDP.

Some candidates have also shown a change in their criminal records.

Both these need further investigation by the Police and the Income Tax Authorities.

Matters of concern

The continuing criminalization of politics is a concern though the level of serious crime in Karnataka has shown a serious decline with 10 such candidates having a total of 15 serious charges against them. In addition there are another 17 candidates with criminal charges.

As media reports seem to indicate, the misuse of monetary incentives to buy votes has increased sharply since 2008 and continues to be a source of threat to real democracy. While voter awareness on this issue is very high, the problem is that those who win after spending huge amounts are unlikely to focus on good governance. They are more likely to focus on recovering the funds they spent and on giving favours to those who supported their campaigns.

The entry of big money into politics is another issue. While a healthy relationship between business and Government is welcome, it should not cross some clear cut boundaries. Several recent legislations seem to favour business interests over people's interests leading to conflicts. As in other countries we need legislation to avoid all conflict of interest.

For the first time, the election campaigns have become far more competitive. As a result we see hate speeches, personal abuse against candidates, high pitched appeals based on religion and caste, and misuse of money to buy votes. The NEW network will take this issue to voters and ask them to think twice before voting for people indulging in such electoral campaigns.
